 - Omicron variant is now the most prominent in MN
 - 7-Day Rolling Averages (Feb 16/Feb 8/Feb 1)
 - o **% of Tests COVID Positive:** 7.2%/14.4%/14.3%
 - O Daily New Cases per 100K Residents: 27.3/49.0/79.3
 - O New COVID Hospital Admissions per 100K Residents: 12.0/17.5/22.7

 - Safety Committee Walk through of 8/9 corridor today to prepare for OSHA Consultation
 - WETT
 - Chain on top of mounted ladder to raised platform needs to be used
 - Crane inspection needs to be verified
 - Items need to be removed from on top of flammable cabinets
 - Items in fridge needs labels
 - Items on cabinet on mezzanine needs to be removed (no 18" clearance)
 - Needs "eye protection required" sign on entrance doors
 - Many pails and empty coffee cans need to have covers and labels
 - Old motor under table as deficient cable discard
 - Items in front of fire extinguisher & eyewash station needs to be moved
 - HVAC
- Propane tank on desk not stored properly
- · No load rating on mezzanine
- Items on top of electrical panel
- Items in front of panels at back of room
- No label on waste oil bucket
- Waste oil bucket cap/plug missing
- Extension cord on floor not stored properly
- Items blocking pull station
- Several buckets with no labels
- Overhead beams on mezzanine level need yellow tape
- Items in front of fire extinguisher

- Plumbing Steve Gilmore present
 - Propane tanks not being stored properly
 - · No load rating on mezzanine
 - Questionable flammable fluids closet
 - Wet floor needs slip hazard sign
 - Needs "eye protection required" sign on entrance doors
 - Exhaust fan dial/plate is loose (by hallway door)
 - · No sprinkler heads in storage room
- Carpentry
 - Blue extension cord has bad ground
 - Pails within 3 feet of fire suppression
 - Items within 3 feet of electrical boxes
- Electrical
 - · Extension cords on floor not stored properly
 - Openings below panels
 - · Buckets need labels
 - Needs load rating on mezzanine
 - Several locks removed from lock out/tag out circuits
- All labs Need lock out/tag out checks completed
