There is a Program Information and Tool Day on Thursday, June 8, 2023. Come to meet the instructors, see the shop, and we will be available to answer your questions.

Check-in is at 10 am in Room 235 you may enter at the Main entrance and they will direct you. This is where you may ask questions about the college, financial aid and scholarships, and about the program.

On this day, we will also be running our Transportation Tool Day in the Truck Shop. The Truck Shop in Room 270 is located on the West side of the campus, near Door 15. There will be several vendors displaying their products from 11am through 2pm. To place an order for tools through the vendors, you may need about 15-20% down. Actual prices vary by vendor.

Student tools should **not** be delivered to St. Cloud Technical and Community College - have them delivered to your residency (home) so you can do an accurate inventory. Toolboxes can be dropped off the first week of school between 8 am and 2 pm.

Auto Body Tools - The approximate cost is \$4,000.

It is strongly recommended that you attend Tool Day. After this day, you will be responsible to contact the tool vendors to make arrangements to receive your tools by the time school starts.

Financial Aid is not paid out until the second week of school. Please make sure to make financial arrangements.
