This 60-credit degree constitutes the first two years of a baccalaureate degree at most colleges and universities. The AA degree provides students with a broad base of classes to help develop key communication and critical thinking skills and exposes students to new and diverse ideas. The AA degree is a stackable credential that students can use in a career or as a basis for further academic studies.
