Class Climate Task Force

Purpose

The task force will recommend a survey instrument to be used to gather information about student perceptions of instruction in accordance with policy 3.25, Student Course Feedback. The survey should be useful for individual faculty and administrators who are responsible for oversight of academic programs.

Primary Responsibilities

The task force will review the current class climate survey, research other surveys and their use as needed, and formulate a set of questions to use going forward. Members may also work with academic affairs to select an administration platform.

The task force may also recommend guidelines on the administration of the survey including timeline, communications, and use of the data.

Task force members will work collaboratively with the Academic Affairs leadership group, which includes the Vice President of Academic Affairs & Institutional Effectiveness, all Academic Deans, and the Director of Nursing.

Meeting Schedule

The task force will meet on a schedule determined by consensus of the members. The group may work synchronously or asynchronously.

Membership and Terms

Members will serve for the duration of the task force, and a chair or co-chairs will be selected by consensus of the members.
