#### **SCTCC EMPLOYER RECRUITMENT POLICY**

The St. Cloud Technical & Community College (SCTCC) JobNet is an online platform managed by the Career Center to provide a one stop shop for employers to share employment, internship and volunteer opportunities with SCTCC students, recent graduates and alumni. JobNet is powered by College Central Network. The SCTCC Career Center does not currently use Handshake. Access to JobNet can be obtained by sending an email to <a href="mailto:careerservices@sctcc.edu">careerservices@sctcc.edu</a>. The SCTCC JobNet website acts as a referral service by permitting employers to post information about current job listings to SCTCC students, recent

graduates, and alumni. Employers post online through <a href="collegecentral.com/sctcc">collegecentral.com/sctcc</a> using a professional email address, phone number and business website that would be typically associated with a legal entity. #### **SPRING ANNUAL JOB FAIR**

This signature event has been held for over 30 years, typically offered the last Wednesday in March at River's Edge Convention Center. This event space allows for up to 200 employers in anticipation of an average 600 students/graduates in attendance. Our faculty provides release time from class to attend the event with shuttle bus transportation to and from the college to the convention center. The main purpose of this event is to partner with Central Minnesota Regional Employers to connect with our students and graduates from over 90 academic programs at the college. We encourage employers to promote internships and job opportunities for students upon or after graduation. Plan early to participate in this event as it regularly fills up. Registration opens in January and closes prior to March 1st annually. Registration takes place in JobNet, powered by College Central Network. #### **ON-CAMPUS INFORMATION TABLES**

Employer tabling is held in two locations: Health Sciences Building main entrance and Northway Building next to the cafeteria. Contact Career Services if you are not sure which location is right for you. Consider tabling as an option to promote jobs for students while going to college. In addition, we have health care academic programs that don't attend Job Fair and we encourage tabling in the Health Sciences Building as an alternate option. Employers must be approved in JobNet to table on campus. We reserve the right to limit the number of times employers table per semester.
