SCTCC EMPLOYER RECRUITMENT POLICY

The St. Cloud Technical & Community College (SCTCC) JobNet is an online platform managed by the Career Center to provide a one stop shop for employers to share employment, internship and volunteer opportunities with SCTCC students, recent graduates and alumni. JobNet is powered by College Central Network. The SCTCC Career Center does not currently use Handshake. Access to JobNet can be obtained by sending an email to careerservices@sctcc.edu. The SCTCC JobNet website acts as a referral service by permitting employers to post information about current job listings to SCTCC students, recent

graduates, and alumni. Employers post online through collegecentral.com/sctcc using a professional email address, phone number and business website that would be typically associated with a legal entity. Employers can learn more about these events in JobNet, powered by college Central Network. Log into your existing account and be sure your account stays up to date or create a new account to receive announcements and updates. Our goal is to partner with Central Minnesota Regional Employers to connect with our students and graduates from over 90 academic programs at SCTCC. We encourage employers to promote internships and job opportunities for students, both during and after graduation. Due to the limited space on campus, we anticipate that these events will fill up quickly.

SCTCC has offered an annual job fair for over 30 years, most recently at River's Edge Convention Center in St. Cloud, MN. The transition from a single job fair to multiple events will enable us to become more agile in meeting the

hiring needs of employers, as well as the timing of when students seek jobs, internships and apprenticeships. The advantages of this shift includes lower costs for employers, increased student engagement, and the opportunity to visit campus and connect with faculty.







EMPLOYER CONNECTION EVENTS

Employer Connection Events are by invitation only and a collaboration between Career Services and the academic program faculty. We offer these events to ensure that we continue to provide just-in-time services to our employer partners and students in educational programs with internship and/or hiring needs that occur outside the traditional



spring events such as Heating, Air Conditioning & Refrigeration students; and Transportation students in Auto Body Collision Tech, Automotive Services Tech, and Medium/Heavy Truck Technician.


ON-CAMPUS INFORMATION TABLES
